HLTAID003 – Provide First Aid

This unit of competency incorporates training in the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

Effective delivery of lifesaving first aid interventions requires regular instruction and practical training, particularly, when an incident especially relates to potentially fatal illnesses and injuries.

The unit is available to all persons who wish to attain competency in the provision of first aid and is applicable for all workers who may be required to provide a first aid response, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

This course equips participants with the skills, knowledge and confidence to:

- provide first aid treatment to a casualty who is suffering from a sudden illness/injury in order to preserve life, prevent further harm & promote recovery
- recognise when someone is in sudden cardiac arrest i.e. unresponsive and not breathing or not breathing normally
- increase casualty's chance of survival by calling for emergency services and performing potentially lifesaving cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) including uninterrupted compressions and the application of a defibrillator (if available) until emergency services arrive and take over
- manage other life-threatening situations such as choking, asthma & anaphylaxis
- manage first aid situations such as unconscious breathing casualty, bleeding, burns, shock, soft tissue injuries, fractures, envenomation

Course Delivery & Duration

Assessment Requirements & Competency Award

It is a requirement of the Training Package for this course that each participant is physically capable of performing uninterrupted compressions and rescue breaths for at least two minutes on a CPR manikin placed on the floor.

To achieve competency, participants undertaking this course are expected to successfully complete written and practical assessment including:

- Performance Tasks
- Practical Scenarios
- Written theory assessment consisting of multiple-choice questions

A statement of attainment will be issued by <u>Allens Training Pty Ltd RTO 90909</u> to participants who successfully complete the nationally recognised training for:

- HLTAID003 Provide First Aid which includes
- HLTAID001 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and
- HLTAID002 Provide Basic First Aid
